

RESOLUTION ADOPTING A LOCAL LAW AMENDING CHAPTER 265, VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, ARTICLE II, PARKING REGULATIONS, §265-40.1 PARKING OR STANDING PROHIBITED DURING SCHOOL HOURS

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Village of Sag Harbor is considering amending Village Code §265-40.1, Parking or Standing Prohibited during School Hours pursuant to a request submitted from the Sag Harbor School District by letter dated 9/12/22; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held by the Board of Trustees on Tuesday, November 8, 2022 at which time all persons either for or against the proposed local law were heard; and

WHEREAS, the adoption of the proposed local law represents a Type II Action pursuant to 6 NYCRR Part 617.5(c)(22), provisions of the New York State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA); and now therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the following local law is hereby adopted:

LOCAL LAW NO. 18 OF 2022

A LOCAL LAW amending Chapter 265, Vehicles and Traffic, Article II, Parking Regulations, §265-40.1 Parking or Standing Prohibited During School Hours

Be it enacted, by the Village Board of Trustees of the Village of Sag Harbor as follows:

SECTION 1. Amendment.

Please see the following and amend Village Code §265-44B by adding those words that are underlined and deleting those words that are stricken as follows:

§265-40.1 Parking or standing prohibited during school hours.

Parking or standing is prohibited during school hours as follows:

Name of Street	Side	Hours	Location
East Union Street	North	8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.	Entire length from Rysam Street to Division Street.

SECTION 2. Severability.

If any clause, sentence, paragraph, section or part of this local law shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder of this local law but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, section or part of this local law that shall be directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment shall be rendered.

SECTION 3. Effective Date.

This chapter shall take effect immediately upon filing in the office of the Secretary of State pursuant to the Municipal Home Rule Law.
